

Agastache foeniculum

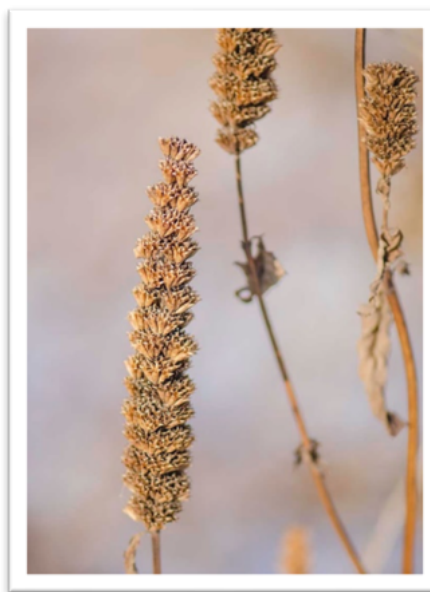
Anise Hyssop, Blue Giant Hyssop



Plant type:	Perennial
Season of Interest:	Summer to Fall
Height: 2-4'	Spread: 1-3'
Water needs:	Low - Moist
Native Region:	CO, NE WY
Elevation:	6,500-8,000'
Important to know:	Dead head to promote additional blooms



Maintenance:	Medium
Characteristics:	Licorice-scented foliage and seeds
Garden Uses:	Banks, Slopes, Informal Beds and Borders
Habitat:	Forest openings
Caution:	<i>Agastache rugosa</i> , a non-native, is a close look-alike and often mistakenly traded as <i>A. foeniculum</i> .



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Clump division or by seed. Cold moist stratification improves germination; seeds require light, sow with very light cover, germinates 1-4 weeks.
