

# *Agoseris aurantiaca*

## Orange Agoseris, Mountain Dandelion



<b>Plant type:</b>	Perennial
<b>Season of Interest:</b>	June - August
<b>Height:</b> 12"	<b>Spread:</b> 6"
<b>Water needs:</b>	Moist
<b>Native Region:</b>	CO, Western US
<b>Elevation:</b>	5,400' - 12,500'



<b>Maintenance:</b>	Low
<b>Characteristics:</b>	Leaves are edible
<b>Habitat:</b>	Forest openings, mountain meadows



### Ease of Propagation: Medium

**Propagation:** Fruits are mature when the spreading action of the drying pappus opens the head. Store seeds dry at 40°. Cold stratify for 3 weeks, or sow in February and leave outdoors. Plant seeds vertically. 14-28 days to germinate if controlled (greenhouse) environment.
