Propagation: Fruits are mature when the spreading action of the drying pappus opens the head. Store seeds dry at 40°. Cold stratify for 3 weeks, or sow in February and leave outdoors. Plant seeds vertically. 14-28 days to germinate if controlled (greenhouse) environment.
