## Ease of Propagation: Medium

**Propagation**: After ripen, store dry at 40-70°F for 6 months before sowing or cold stratification. Some people cold stratify for 1 month and some just sow the seeds in May after the after-ripening period. Either way seeds germinate at 70°F. Cover the seeds to depth.
