# Saskatoon Serviceberry



**Plant type:** Perennial  
**Season of Interest:** July-Dec  
**Height:** 10-15' **Spread:** 10-15'  
**Water needs:** Medium  
**Native Region:** CO, NE, UT, WY  
**Elevation:** 4,700'-11,000'  
**Important to know:** Serviceberry fruit has a sugar content of 20%, sweeter than blueberries and raspberries.



**Maintenance:** Low  
**Garden Uses:** Beds, Borders, Hedges & Screens  
**Habitat:** Dry Hillsides, canyons, aspen forests, pinyon-juniper, or sage brush



## Ease of Propagation: Easy

**Propagation:** Division, dormant root cutting, seed propagation. For seed propagation, sow outdoors in the fall, or cold stratify for 120 days with a 12-hour tepid water soak midway through.
