Dwarf Leadplant



Plant type:	Perennial shrub/subshrub
Season of Interest:	Summer
Height: 2-3'	Spread: 2-3'
Water needs:	moderate to xeric
Native Region:	CO, KS, NE, NM, OK
Elevation:	to 7,200' to 4,000'-8,000'
Important to know:	Perfect for challenging, full-sun spots in the garden



Maintenance:	None required
Characteristics:	Cut flowers, showy, fragrant
Garden Uses:	Beds/borders
Habitat:	Rocky slopes, grasslands



Ease of Propagation: Medium

Propagation: Scarify seeds with sandpaper. Boiling water soak (pour boiling water over the seeds. Let it cool and soak 12-24 hours). Cold stratify 30 days. Inoculate (opt). Sow seeds on a well-draining mix at 70°F. Cover very lightly with mix or fine vermiculite. Seeds germinate in 1 week.
