

(reseeds)

Season of Interest: Summer

Water needs: Moderate, low, dry, xeric

Native Region: CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY

Elevation: to 8,000'

Important to know: Long-blooming, showy annual is a

focal point in any dry garden.

Poisonous if ingested.





**Habitat:** Plains, foothills, dry grasslands, open

slopes, roadsides





**Ease of Propagation: Easy** 

Propagation: Sow in situ outside in mid-

to-late fall. Cover lightly.

Annuals can be started in cells/pots in the spring. Use light cover material.
