# Fringed Sage



<b>Plant type:</b>	Rhizomatous Perennial
<b>Season of Interest:</b>	Summer to late fall
<b>Height:</b> 6-18"	<b>Spread:</b> 1-2'
<b>Water needs:</b>	Low, xeric
<b>Native Region:</b>	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, TX, UT, WY
<b>Elevation:</b>	to 12,500'
<b>Important to know:</b>	Companion plant with paintbrush



<b>Maintenance:</b>	Average
<b>Characteristics:</b>	Showy, fragrant, semi-evergreen
<b>Garden Uses:</b>	Beds/borders, patio/containers, rock garden
<b>Habitat:</b>	Open, dry, sometimes rocky places

## Ease of Propagation: Medium

**Propagation:** Seed viable for 2-3 years, so use fresh seed. Sow after the last frost date. Ideally, the night time temperature is above 50°F. Lightly cover the seeds and make sure they do not dry out. Germinate in 1 week.

Vegetative reproduction by cuttings (Feb-May) and by layering.
