Artemisia frigida

Fringed Sage



Water needs: Low, xeric

Native Region: CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, TX, UT, WY

Elevation: to 12,500'

Important to know: Companion plant with paintbrush



Maintenance: Average

Characteristics: Showy, fragrant, semi-evergreen **Garden Uses:** Beds/borders, patio/containers, rock

garden

Habitat: Open, dry, sometimes rocky places



Ease of Propagation: Medium

Propagation: Seed viable for 2-3 years, so use fresh seed. Sow after the last frost date. Ideally, the night time temperature is above 50°F. Lightly cover the seeds and make sure they do not dry out. Germinate in 1 week.

Vegetative reproduction by cuttings (Feb-May) and by layering.
