# Prairie Sage



<b>Plant type:</b>	Rhizomatous Perennial
<b>Season of Interest:</b>	Summer to fall
<b>Height:</b> 2-3'	<b>Spread:</b> 2-3'
<b>Water needs:</b>	Low
<b>Native Region:</b>	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
<b>Elevation:</b>	to 11,200'
<b>Important to know:</b>	Beautiful blue-green foliage. Spreads rhizomatously throughout the garden, aggressively if watered.



<b>Maintenance:</b>	Average (monitor its spread)
<b>Characteristics:</b>	Fragrant, Showy
<b>Garden uses:</b>	Beds & Borders
<b>Habitat:</b>	Semi-desert, foothills, montane, alpine. Meadows, woodlands.

## Ease of Propagation: Easy

**Propagation:** By division or seed. For seed, direct sow seeds with very light cover on the surface of the soil in late fall. For spring planting, cold stratify with moist sand in refrigerator (40°F) for 1 month before direct sowing. with very light cover indoors or outdoors when 65-70°F. Transplant indoor seedlings as soon as they develop a good root system. [Everwilde Farms, Inc]
