

Cleome trachysperma

Red-Whisker Clammyweed



Plant type: Annual
Season of Interest: Mid-summer to early fall
Height: 20-40" **Spread:** 10-20"
Water needs: Low, xeric
Native Region: CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation: to 6,800'
Important to know: Great at the back of sunny border, good for erosion control, best planted in mass



Maintenance: Low
Characteristics: Cut flowers, showy
Garden Uses: Beds/borders, banks/slopes
Habitat: Deserts, plains, sandy slopes, washes, disturbed areas, Pinyon-Juniper

Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Late fall to winter, right before a snow, sow seeds of this annual outside where you want the plants to germinate. It can be sown in pots in late winter. Plant as soon as it has a few true leaves.
