Showy, Semi-evergreen

Moist meadows, alpine tundra, along
lake margins, wetlands



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Sow heavily in cells or in situ in
mid-March in the Front Range, light cover.
Heavy germination in 1 month. Began to pot
mid-May.
