Plant type:	Biennial or short-lived perennial
Season of Interest:	Late summer to Fall
Height:	up to 3'
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry, xeric
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 12,000'



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Cut flowers, showy
Garden uses:	Pollinator garden
Habitat:	Open hillsides, roadsides, meadows.



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Store seeds dry at 40°F or 70°F for 3-6 months before sowing (after-ripen). Sow seeds at 70°F. Cover very lightly to meet the light requirement but still retain some moisture around the seeds.
