Engelmann's Daisy



Plant type:	Perennial (may reseed)
Season of Interest:	Early spring to late fall
Height: 1-3'	Spread: 1-2'
Water needs:	Moderate to xeric
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NM, OK, TX
Elevation:	to 6,200'; cultivated to 7,500'
Important to know:	Incredibly tough and adaptable



Maintenance:	Prune back/shear to ground in spring.
Characteristics:	Showy
Garden uses:	Beds/borders
Habitat:	Prairie, roadsides



Ease of Propagation: Easy
