Native Region: CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY

**Elevation:** to 9,500'

Important to know: Self-seeds readily. Can

overwhelm small gardens. Cut back in early spring to promote

branching





Maintenance: Low

Characteristics: Showy, fragrant

**Garden uses:** Banks/slopes, hedges

**Habitat:** Plains, foothills, mesas, desert scrub,

grasslands





**Propagation:** Seed viable for 3 years if stored dry at 40°F. Sow seeds in situ or in cells early winter (December). Cover lightly. They germinate about 4 weeks before the last frost in spring.
