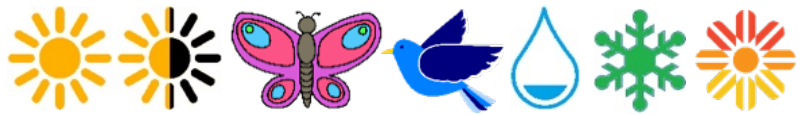


# *Ericameria nauseosa*

## Rabbitbrush, Rubber Rabbitbrush, Chamisa



<b>Plant type:</b>	Shrub (may reseed)
<b>Season of Interest:</b>	Late summer to mid-fall
<b>Height:</b> 1-7'	<b>Spread:</b> 2-3'
<b>Water needs:</b>	Low, xeric
<b>Native Region:</b>	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
<b>Elevation:</b>	to 9,500'
<b>Important to know:</b>	Self-seeds readily. Can overwhelm small gardens. Cut back in early spring to promote branching



<b>Maintenance:</b>	Low
<b>Characteristics:</b>	Showy, fragrant
<b>Garden uses:</b>	Banks/slopes, hedges
<b>Habitat:</b>	Plains, foothills, mesas, desert scrub, grasslands



### Ease of Propagation: Easy

**Propagation:** Seed viable for 3 years if stored dry at 40°F. Sow seeds in situ or in cells early winter (December). Cover lightly. They germinate about 4 weeks before the last frost in spring.
