Sleepy Grass



Plant type:	Perennial cool season bunch grass
Season of Interest:	Summer
Height: 2-4'	Spread: 1-2'
Water needs:	Low
Native Region:	CO , AZ , NM , WY
Elevation:	5,400' - 10,000'
Important to know:	Potential as an ornamental grass, particularly in arid regions with cold winters
Synonym:	<i>Achnatherum robustum</i>



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Winter Interest
Garden uses:	Beds/Borders
Habitat:	Meadows, dry plains and hills, in open woods and forest clearings, canyons and along roadsides

Ease of Propagation: Medium

Propagation: Scarify with sandpaper then follow with 2 month cold moist stratification (40°F) by sowing either in situ, in cells outside or in moist medium in refrigerator. Sow to 1/8" depth. [Western Native Seed]
