# Annual Buckwheat



<b>Plant type:</b>	Annual
<b>Season of Interest:</b>	Spring - Fall
<b>Height:</b> 1-3'	<b>Spread:</b> 1'
<b>Water needs:</b>	Low
<b>Native Region:</b>	CO, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, WY
<b>Elevation:</b>	up to 7,500'
<b>Important to know:</b>	Adds white lacy floral height to gardens turning pink to rust in fall



## Maintenance:

**Characteristics:** Dried arrangements, showy

**Garden uses:** Beds and Borders, Pollinator gardens

**Habitat:** Dry slopes, sand hills, prairie



## Ease of Propagation: Medium

**Propagation:** After-ripen seeds at 70°F then store seeds dry at 40F. Cold moist stratification not necessary but can't hurt. Sow seeds in spring (after last frost) or fall in a well-drained soil.
