Plant type:	Biennial
Season of Interest:	Late Spring to Mid-Summer
Height: 1-2'	Spread: 6' - 1'
Water needs:	Low, Average
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	up to 13,500'
Important to know:	Flowers can be yellow, orange or purplish-pink

Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: No pre-treatment necessary. End of April (at 5,690') sow in situ or in cells/pots with light cover. Germination in 10 days.
