

Euphorbia marginata

Snow on the Mountain



Plant type:	Annual (reseeds)
Season of Interest:	Late spring to late summer
Height: 12-30"	Spread: 1-2'
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 7,000'
Important to know:	Toxic if ingested; sap causes skin irritation. Opportunistically spreads by seed.



Habitat: Plains, shortgrass prairie, disturbed areas, roadsides



Ease of Propagation: Medium

Propagation: One month of cold stratification followed by a high germination temperature (up to 86-90°F daytime and 68°F at night or at least not below 40°F) results in good germination. The seeds should be covered to depth whether sown in cells or directly in the ground. If sowing in situ, sow 3 weeks before the last frost.
