

Helianthus maximiliani

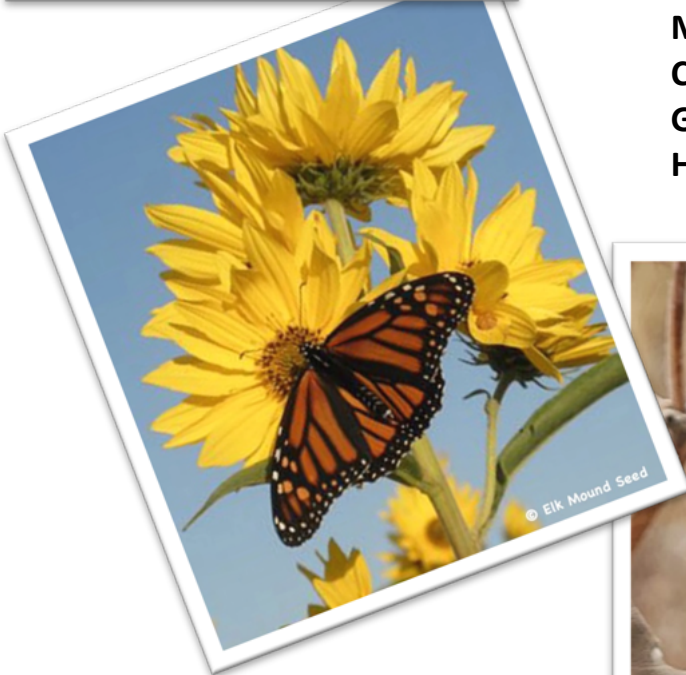
Maximilian Sunflower



Plant type:	Perennial (may reseed)
Season of Interest:	Late summer to early fall
Height: 3-8'	Spread: 2-5'
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry
Native Region:	CO, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, WY
Elevation:	to 6,000'
Important to know:	Not suited to small gardens, needs lots of room to spread



Maintenance:	Average
Characteristics:	Cut flowers, showy
Garden uses:	Beds/borders
Habitat:	Plains, moist prairie, ditches



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Store seeds dry at 40°F or 70°F. Cold stratify for 6 weeks before sowing at 70-85°F. Cover lightly.
