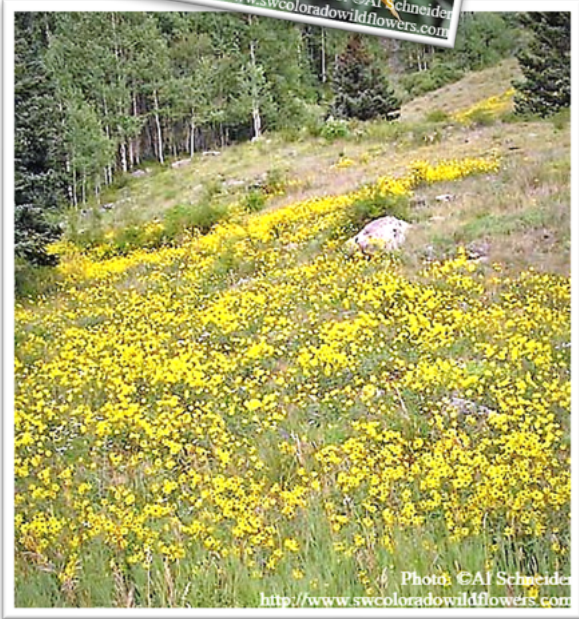
# Showy Goldeneye



<b>Plant type:</b>	Perennial (reseeds)
<b>Season of Interest:</b>	Late summer to early fall
<b>Height:</b> 10-24"	<b>Spread:</b> 12-24"
<b>Water needs:</b>	Low, xeric
<b>Native Region:</b>	CO, AZ, NM, TX, UT, WY
<b>Elevation:</b>	to 11,000'
<b>Important to know:</b>	Hardy and easy to grow, keep an eye out for aphids. Prolific self-seeder.



<b>Maintenance:</b>	Low
<b>Characteristics:</b>	Cut flowers, showy
<b>Garden uses:</b>	Beds/borders, patio/containers
<b>Habitat:</b>	Desert steppe, foothills, meadows, roadsides, disturbed sites



## Ease of Propagation: Medium

**Propagation:** Keep seeds dry at 70°F for a year to after-ripen. Sow at 70-80°F. Cover lightly with soil. OR Cold stratify fairly fresh seeds for 4-6 weeks. Then sow at 70-80°F. Cover lightly.
