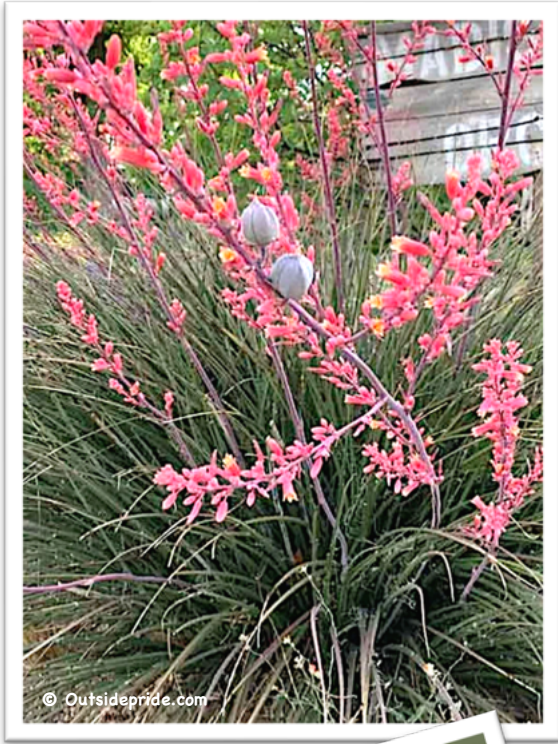


Hesperaloe parviflora

Red Yucca



Plant type:	Cactus, succulents, perennial
Season of Interest:	Late spring to late fall
Height: 3-5'	Spread: 4-6'
Water needs:	Low, xeric
Native Region:	TX
Elevation:	to 6,200'
Important to know:	Use rock mulch if possible. Provide additional moisture in mid-summer for best performance.



Maintenance:	Trim flower stems back to base of plant every early spring.
Characteristics:	showy, evergreen
Garden uses:	Beds/borders, patio/containers
Habitat:	



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Clump division or by seed. By seed, cold stratify for 90 days, then soak in tepid water bath for 3 days changing water daily. Sow at 70-80°F and cover to depth. After germination, move quickly to ground to avoid root bounding.
