Cut down after hard frost, but leave some to self-seed and feed birds

margins, sand dunes, scrub





Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Store seeds dry at 40°F. Sow after the last frost in situ or in cells. Cover lightly and keep moist. Seeds germinate at 70°F and above.
