**Plant type:**

Biennial, Short-lived Perennial

**Season of Interest:**

July-Oct

**Height:** 1-3'

**Spread:** 2-4'

**Water needs:**

Low to Xeric

**Native Region:**

CO, AZ, NM, TX, UT, WY

**Elevation:**

6,000-9,800'

**Important to know:**

Seeds heavily in the garden. Basal leaves are maroon in Spring and Fall; Important larval & adult host for many insects



**Maintenance:**

Low

**Habitat:**

Roadsides, rocky crevices and meadows



## Ease of Propagation: Easy

**Propagation:** Sow after last frost date. 70L, very light cover. Heavy germination occurs from 7-28 days. This biennial to short-lived perennial self-seeds heavily in the garden.
