Plant type:	Biennial/Perennial
Season of Interest:	Mid to late summer
Height: 18-36"	Spread: 6-12"

Important to know:	Tolerates light shade, water until well established.

Ease of Propagation: Medium

Propagation: Seed viability best within 2 yrs. Sow the seeds shortly after collection in situ. For stored seeds, cold stratify for 30 days, then sow with light cover indoors or outdoors once temps are 70° F with light cover. Leaves emerge in 3 weeks.
