

Ipomopsis rubra

Scarlet Gilia, Texas Plume, Standing Cypress



Plant type:	Biennial
Season of Interest:	Summer
Height: 2-4'	Spread: 1-2'
Water needs:	Low
Native Region:	TX, OK, Southeast
Elevation:	to 6,000'
Important to know:	When the bloom stalk is through blooming, you can prune it off to allow replacement stalk to grow and flower. Prolific re-seeder.



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Can be an annual that readily self-sows.
Garden uses:	Beds, Borders, Prairie & Meadow
Habitat:	Dry, sandy or rocky fields; open woods.



Ease of Propagation: Medium

Propagation: Direct sow in situ in fall, cover with 1/16" soil. Or, start inside 6-8 weeks before the last frost in spring. Transplant to the ground as soon as possible.
