Characteristics: Can be an annual that readily self-

sows.

**Garden uses:** Beds, Borders, Prairie & Meadow **Habitat:** Dry, sandy or rocky fields; open

woods.









Propagation: Direct sow in situ in fall, cover with 1/16" soil. Or, start inside 6-8 weeks before the last frost in spring. Transplant to the ground as soon as possible.
