Plant type:	Perennial cool season grass
Season of Interest:	Spring - Early Summer
Height: 1-2'	Spread: 1-2'
Water needs:	Low, Average
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX UT, WY
Elevation:	up to 12,000'
Important to know:	Companion plants should be later bloomers to mask its late-summer dormancy



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Showy, Cool-season, clump-forming bunch grass
Garden uses:	Rock Garden, Prairie, Meadow
Habitat:	Meadows, shortgrass prairie, woodlands, sagebrush



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Mid-March in the Front Range, sow pinches of seeds in cells with very light cover. Put outside. Leaves emerge in 30-40 days in cool temperatures.
