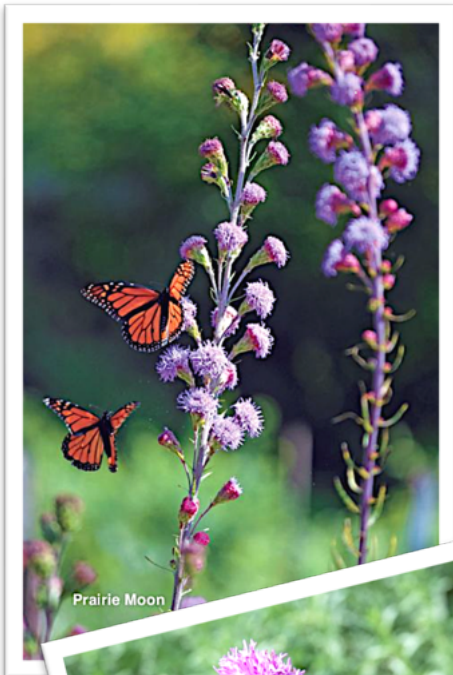


Liatris ligulistylus

Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Cold stratify for 2 months either in the fridge or in cells sown in Feb. (5690') and put outside. Press the seeds into the soil and/or cover them to depth. Germination (radicle) about day 60 and leaves 2-3 weeks later. They bloom in 2-3 years. If the soil is quite rich and moist the plants can get to 5' and require staking.
