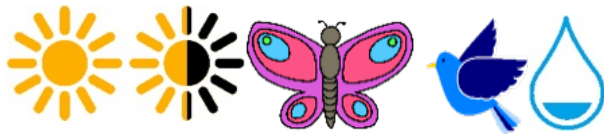


Machaeranthera tanacetifolia

Tansyleaf Tansyaster Tahoka Daisy



Plant type:	Annual/biennial
Season of Interest:	Late spring to early fall
Height: 6-18"	Spread: 10-18"
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry
Native Region:	CO, AZ, NM, TX, UT
Elevation:	to 7,000'
Important to know:	Grows well between flagstones



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Showy. Deeply dissected leaf structure easily distinguishes it from <i>Dieteria</i> species.
Garden uses:	Banks/slopes
Habitat:	Plains, slopes, shortgrass meadow



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Store seeds dry at 40°F. No pretreatment is necessary. Sow seeds in May after the last frost date, cover very lightly. Seeds will germinate in 8 days, even if temperature is 20°F below normal.
