Crownleaf Evening Primrose



Plant type:

Rhizomatous perennial

Season of Interest:

Late spring to summer

Height: 12-24"

Spread: 6"

Water needs:

Low, xeric

Native Region:

CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, UT, WY

Elevation:

to 9,700'

Important to know:

Spreads well, but easily managed. Easily shared - divisions transplant well.



Habitat:

Foothills, plains, dry slopes, shortgrass prairie



Ease of Propagation: Easy by division

Difficult by seed

Propagation: Sow seeds in situ in fall. Barely cover with soil. [Dorn & Dorn, "Growing Native Plants of the Rocky Mountain Area"]
