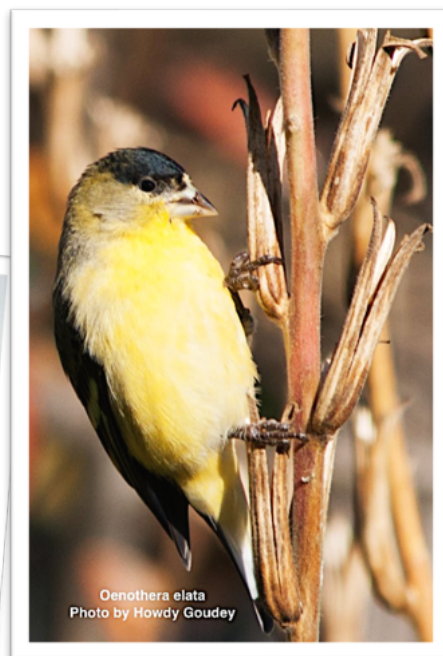

Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: No pretreatment OR
30-day cool moist stratification OR
plant outside in situ fall to spring.
Sow seeds on soil surface or to 1/16-
inch depth.
