Hairy/Common Evening Primrose



Plant type:	Biennial, short-lived perennial
Season of Interest:	Summer
Height: 24-48"	Spread: 18" x 32"
Water needs:	Average, low
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 9,500'
Important to know:	Evening bloomer, attracts nocturnal pollinators like moths



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Named for the soft hairs that uniformly cover plant
Habitat:	Foothills, plains, dry slopes, disturbed sites



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: No pretreatment. Plant seeds outside fall to spring. Plant to 1/16" deep. Seeds take 3-4 weeks to germinate. [westernnativeseed.com]
