## Ease of Propagation: Medium

**Propagation:** Begin treatments Feb. 1 (5690'). Rinse for 3 days using a bubbler or by soaking in a small bowl of water and changing the water every day. Cold stratify at 40°F for 3 months. Sow outside (in cells or situ) with light cover when temps hit ~70°F outside. Germination within 3.5 months.
