Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Store seeds dry at 40°F. To propagate, soak the seeds for 3 hours in tepid water. Sow seeds with very light cover 12 weeks before the last frost date in situ or in containers. If in containers, put outside for chilling. Seeds germinate in about 2.5 months at 40°F-55°F.
