## **Bridges' Penstemon**



**Plant type:** Perennial

Season of Interest: Mid-summer to early fall

**Height:** 24-36" **Spread:** 24-36"

**Water needs:** Moderate, low, dry, xeric

Native Region: CO, AZ, NM, UT

**Elevation:** to 7,000'; cultivated to 8,125'

Important to know: Hand trim back dead stems in spring.



## **Ease of Propagation: Easy**

Propagation: Cold stratification best achieved outside. Sow in cells or in situ 3 months before the last frost date with very light cover. Outside treatment in cells requires regular piling on of snow. Leaves emerge 85 days after sowing.
