

Penstemon rostriflorus

Bridges' Penstemon



Plant type:	Perennial
Season of Interest:	Mid-summer to early fall
Height: 24-36"	Spread: 24-36"
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry, xeric
Native Region:	CO, AZ, NM, UT
Elevation:	to 7,000'; cultivated to 8,125'
Important to know:	Hand trim back dead stems in spring.



Garden uses: Beds/borders

Habitat: Foothills, canyons, shrublands, forest openings



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Cold stratification best achieved outside. Sow in cells or in situ 3 months before the last frost date with very light cover. Outside treatment in cells requires regular piling on of snow. Leaves emerge 85 days after sowing.
