

Penstemon secundiflorus

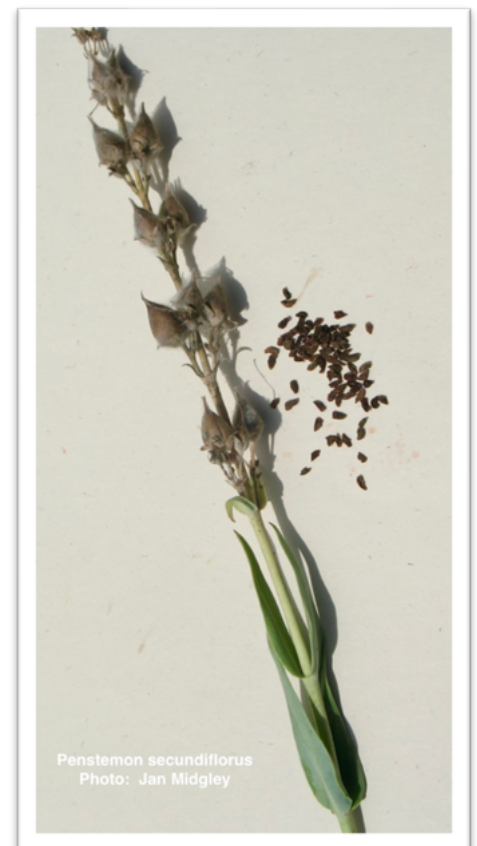
Sidebells Penstemon



Plant type:	Perennial
Season of Interest:	Late spring
Height	6-20" Spread: 4-12"
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry
Native Region:	CO, NM, WY
Elevation:	to 10,500'
Important to know:	Hand trim back dead stems in spring. Important to early season pollinators.



Habitat: Foothills, plains



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Cold stratify the seeds 6-8 weeks at 40°F in the fridge or sow midwinter and put the containers outside. Cover very lightly (light requirement). Outside treatment in cells requires regular piling on of snow. OR Sow late Dec. to Jan. in situ. Cover very lightly. Seeds germinate at 70°F.
