

Penstemon strictus

Rocky Mountain Penstemon/ Beardtongue



Plant type:	Evergreen perennial (reseeds)
Season of Interest:	Mid-spring to early summer; may rebloom in fall
Height: 1-3'	Spread: 1-3'
Water needs:	Moderate, low, dry
Native Region:	CO, AZ, NM, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 11,000'
Important to know:	Self-sows prolifically in gardens; spreads to form a mat



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Showy
Garden uses:	Beds/borders
Habitat:	Montane, foothills, Pinyon-Juniper, Sagebrush



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Cold stratify the seeds at 40°F for 3 months, preferably outside in cells/pots with very light cover. Germination in 10 weeks. Or, sow the seeds in situ in the fall.
