Plant type: Perennial

Season of Interest: Late Spring, Early-Summer

Height: 8" **Spread:** 8-10"

Water needs: Low once established

**Native Region:** CO, WY **Elevation:** to 11,000'

They need "elbow room," maximum Important to know: sun, heat and don't like to be crowded by other plants. They establish quickly and the amount and frequency of watering needs to be reduced after about 8 to 10 weeks to create dry conditions











Maintenance: Low

Characteristics: Fragrant, Showy, Evergreen Garden uses: container, rock garden

**Habitat:** Rocky slopes, rock crevices, forest openings





**Propagation:** Sow the seeds in cells or in situ 2 months before the last frost date with very light cover. Germination in 2 ½ months.
