
Pinus edulis

Pinyon Pine



Plant type: Evergreen Tree
Season of Interest: All year (evergreen)
Height: 10-25' Spread: 10-30'

Water needs: Low

Native Region: CO, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY

Elevation: 4,000-9,500'

Important to know: Evergreen. Slow growing; may take

awhile to get established. Pine nuts

are edible.



Maintenance: Low

Garden uses: Beds, Berms. Accent or screen. **Habitat:** Dry slopes, mesas and canyons,

often with junipers





Ease of Propagation: Medium

Propagation: The egg-shaped seed cones mature 2 years after pollination. Fresh seeds need no treatment; stored seeds 2 mos. stratification; or soak in cold (40°F) water for 24 hrs. (USDA Forest Service 1974); or keep maximum germinating temperature below 73°F.
