Chokecherry



Plant type:	Perennial
Season of Interest:	Spring - Fall
Height: 20'-30'	Spread: 15'-20'
Water needs:	Low-Medium
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	4,000-10,500'
Important to know:	Suckers. Can use ripe berries to create jam, jellies, pies



Ease of Propagation: Difficult

Propagation: Warm stratify the seeds in moist sand for 2 weeks. Then cold stratify (36-41°F) for 60-90 days. Plant well before high temperatures. [wildflower.org]
When sowing, cover to depth.
