American Pasque Flower



Plant type:	Perennial
Season of Interest:	Spring
Height: 3"-1'	Spread: 3"-6"
Water needs:	Low, xeric
Native Region:	CO, KS, NE, NM, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 13,000'
Important to know:	Combines well with spring flowering bulbs and ground cover



Maintenance:	Low
Characteristics:	Showy
Garden uses:	Beds/borders, patio/containers
Habitat:	Montane, foothills, meadows, forests, open hillsides



Ease of Propagation: Easy (if 1st year seed)

Propagation: Sow seeds outside fall to early spring. Plant on the soil surface and cover with a thin layer of sand. (Western Native Seed and Prairie Moon Nursery)
