## **Ease of Propagation: Easy**

**Propagation**: If dry seeds are black they do not germinate. Use the tan seeds.

Cold stratify outdoors sown at depth in cells/pots OR cold stratify in

refrigerator or 1-2 weeks, then sow in deep cells or pots at 65°F. There is no light requirement for germination; cover to depth. Advancing from seedling is more difficult than germination.
