Characteristics: can be single trunked, but mostly

multi-trunks. Can be trained by pruning off suckers kwhen tree is

young.

**Garden uses:** Hedges & Screens **Habitat:** Dry slopes, canyons



(if sown 5-7 days after collection)

**Propagation:** Hand harvest in August. After screening acorns for damage/holes, sow to 1" depth very soon after harvest. Large percent of acorns aren't viable due to insects eating them. To eliminate unviable acorns, put harvested acorns in a bucket of water – those that float aren't viable.
