

Ratibida columnifera

Prairie Coneflower, Mexican Hat



Plant type: Perennial (short-lived; reseeds)
Season of Interest: Summer
Height: 12-30" **Spread:** 12-18"
Water needs: Low, average
Native Region: CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation: to 9,000'
Important to know: Some are yellow, some are rust-red



Maintenance: Low
Characteristics: Showy
Garden uses: Beds/borders
Habitat: Prairie, plains, meadows, foothills, roadsides



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: No cold stratification required, but doesn't hurt. Sow outside in fall or spring with light cover. Germination in 8-21 days at 70° (slower if lower temp).
