Elevation: 3,500-8,500'

Important to know: No thorns. Can use ripe berries to create

jam, jellies, pies





Characteristics: Berries are edible. **Garden uses:** Beds, Borders

Habitat: Dry, often sandy slopes, along ditches

and streams, roadsides





Propagation: From cutting or seed. Soak and ferment the berries in order to remove the fruit from the seeds. Cold stratify the seeds in the fridge or outside for 90-120 days. They can be sown in cells or in situ.
