Plant type:	Rhizomatous perennial
Season of Interest:	Mid to late summer
Height: 2-7'+	Spread: 18-36"
Water needs:	High, moderate, low
Native Region:	CO, AZ, KS, NE, NM, OK, TX, UT, WY
Elevation:	to 9,000'
Important to know:	Deadhead to encourage extra blooms



Maintenance:	Average
Characteristics:	Cut flowers, showy, plant of merit
Garden uses:	beds/borders
Habitat:	Prairie, meadow



Ease of Propagation: Easy

Propagation: Cold stratify (in the refrigerator or outside) seeds for 30 days. Sow and keep moist, cover lightly, 70-75°F. Seeds will germinate in 9-10 days.
