**Propagation:** Unstratified seed can be planted in the fall or stratified seed can be planted in the field in the spring. With no cold, moist stratification approximately 40 percent of the seed will germinate. Pretreatment of cold, moist stratification for 4 to 8 weeks will increase total germination to around 80 percent.
